Members and museum visitors, as we have progressed in our growth as a museum we have grown in the number of aircraft that we are flying and maintaining. In the last couple of years we have added several unique aircraft to our fleet, and in like manner ground vehicles. Along with the growth in aircraft and vehicles the need of membership involvement has grown in proportion!

Recently through the help of our members we just completed the conditional inspection on the T28A (N367NA) and T28B (133131). It was time consuming, sweat and blood were shed, and ultimately the aircraft were returned to airworthy condition! This was all due to the great help of over twenty five members!

In addition to the T28B conditional inspection we have several opportunities for our members to be directly involved in the flying and maintenance of the aircraft and museum. This is a exciting way for everyone to gain hands on experience with real warbirds (military aircraft) and ground equipment.
