A Bit of Museum "Memory Lane"

Archived Ready Room newsletters dating back to 2013 can be found on the MOF website. As I was putting this newsletter together, I went back to browse some of the information of the past, feeling a bit nostalgic after Pete O'Hare's visitation where I greeted people I hadn't seen in years, all joined together to honor a man who was an integral part of the museum's history, a Marine, a husband, father, and friend to so, so many.

About 10 years ago, my husband, Mark and I joined the Hixson Flight Museum at the Rome Air Show. The museum facilities were in Hixson, TN at the time, and Mark was thrilled to be around the aircraft and spend time with aviation enthusiasts.

How time flies with memories of our first visit to the Hixson hangar and my first interaction with Pete O'Hare who handed over the website to me within the first hours of meeting us, and our subsequent training to docent under the tutelage of Jim Beaver.

As I browse through these old editions, I read (in the July 2014 issue) about the humble beginnings of the museum and the initial restoration of a 1958 Apache which started the idea of the museum, later to be followed by the T-28B. A 1946 Taylorcraft was discovered in a barn in Iowa, while a "project plane" the 752 was recovered in pieces and assembled in July 2012. June 2013 added the T-34C, which was recovered from NAS Oceana. The first hints of the BTD-1 were mentioned in the July 2014 issue which was delivered to Rome on September 24, 2015, in a few pieces. As the years progressed, the membership grew.

Browsing through more editions, I remember the move to Rome (which made us, personally, very happy to have the museum in our "backyard"), the F-14 Tomcat found at the Virginia Aviation Museum, adding Paulding to the locations during COVID with the outdoor display area, playfully called "the petting zoo".

More members, more tours, airshows, and fly-ins, we have come a long way. The future is bright and I for one, look forward to what the future holds for this unique, flying museum with its incredible displays, historic aircraft, vehicles, and most of all, the people that make up the membership and support of the ongoing efforts of the Museum of Flight.
